Leadership is about creating change... and creating change requires a willingness to step into responsibility for things we care about; a solid grounding in our own personal mission (also known as our "True North"); a vision for the future and a network of people to assist in making change happen.

1. Taking Responsibility *(Friday, March 5)*

This is one of our most popular topics for leaders and employees alike—guaranteed to get you thinking differently about the topic of responsibility. What does it really mean to step into 100% responsibility for our lives? Learn the three facets of the drama triangle (persecutor, victim and rescuer) and how these behaviors hold us back from stepping into 100% responsibility.

2. Discovering Our Mission—Our True North *(Friday, March 26)*

Our True North is the place where we use our talents in an arena that aligns with our values to create change in something we are passionate about. This session requires advance preparation in order to receive maximum benefit. Our time together will provide further reflection and insight into gaining clarity and grounding in your True North.

3. Creating a Vision for the Future *(Wednesday, April 14)*

Many people shy away from the topic of vision because they feel it locks them into a certain path. Not only is this untrue, but the truth is that the most successful leaders have the capacity to inspire a vision for the future that will make others want to follow them—anywhere. This session will cover both personal and organizational vision and tools for defining both.

4. Building a Strong Network of Alliances *(Wednesday, May 5)*

Change doesn't happen in a vacuum. Change requires tapping into the resources of others. So, our final session is another of our most popular topics around building a network of strong alliances.
